

# EMERGENCY CODES AND CONTACTS

VENUES WEST

## To report an emergency at WA Athletics Stadium, contact:

Duty Officer	Radio Channel 1 / 0431 657 857	During an Incident
Chief Warden	Radio Channel 1 / 0431 657 857	Duty Officer becomes Chief Warden
Reception	9441 8360	

### When the alert tone sounds:

- Turn two-way radios to channel 1.
- Report to your nearest Warden Station.

### When the evacuation tone sounds:

- Follow Chief Warden's instructions.
- Commence required evacuation procedure.
- Maintain radio silence and await instructions from Chief Warden.



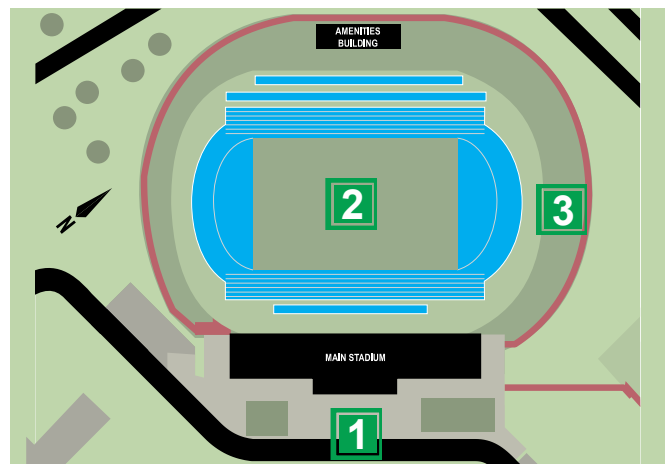
### Alert tones:

- **"BEEP, BEEP, BEEP"**  
**ALERT TONE: Stop** – wait for instructions.
- **"WHOOOP, WHOOOP, WHOOOP"**  
**EVACUATION TONE: Evacuate** – follow staff instructions.

## EMERGENCY CODES

Code	Reason
<b>RED</b>	Fire / Smoke
<b>PURPLE</b>	Bomb Threat
<b>BLUE</b>	Medical Emergency
<b>BLACK</b>	Armed Offender / Active Shooter / Terrorism
<b>YELLOW</b>	Internal emergency
<b>BROWN</b>	External emergency
<b>ORANGE</b>	Evacuation
<b>PINK</b>	Threatening Behaviour
<b>GREEN</b>	All Clear

## ASSEMBLY AREA



- 1** Assemble on main concourse away from immediate danger
- 2** Assemble in the centre of running track away from immediate danger
- 3** Assemble at end of running track away from immediate danger

### AT THE ASSEMBLY AREA

- Account for people from building
- Report any person missing to the Emergency Services
- DO NOT re-enter the building until the "ALL CLEAR" is given by the responding Emergency Services.
